

THE 2010 WINIFRED WARD SCHOLARSHIP

The Winifred Ward Memorial Fund, Inc. is pleased to announce the 33rd Annual Winifred Ward Scholarship, named for the pioneer of children's theatre and creative drama in the United States. The 33rd award of \$8,000 will be given to an outstanding graduate-level student who has demonstrated intellectual and artistic ability in the area of child drama/theatre. In addition, the candidate should indicate a professional interest in pursuing career goals consistent with the legacy of Winifred Ward. To qualify, the student must be a citizen of the United States and have received a bachelor's degree before beginning the graduate degree program.

Nomination letters from graduate programs are due *January 21, 2010* and application materials from nominees are due *March 25, 2010*. Applicants are judged on the basis of scholarship, faculty recommendations, indications of strong professional interest and growth, successful performance in some aspect of children's theatre or creative drama, including but not limited to directing, acting, designing, playwriting, teaching and other criteria.
